



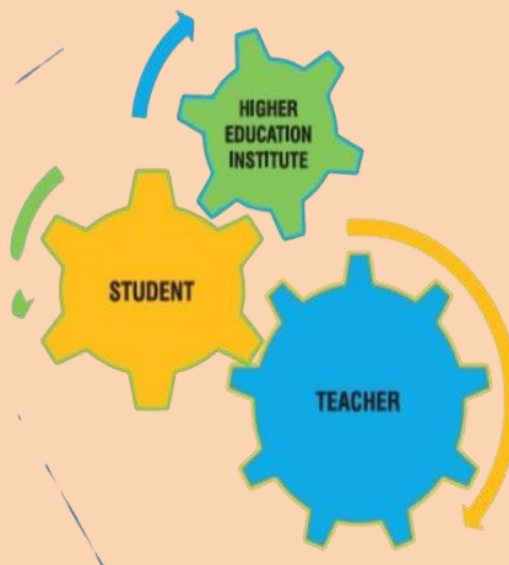

The purpose of Deeksharambh - Student Induction Programme is to help new students adjust and feel comfortable in the new environment, inculcate in them the ethos and culture of the institution, help them build bonds with other students and faculty members, and expose them to a sense of larger purpose and self exploration.

Student Induction Programme engages with the new students as soon as they come into the institution, before regular classes start. At the start of the induction, the incumbents learn about the institutional policies, processes, practices, culture and values, and their mentor groups are formed.

Socializing: meeting other new students, senior students, students union, lectures by Eminent People;

Associating: visits to University / college, visits to Dept./Branch/ Programme of study and important places in campus, local area, city and so on;

Governing: rules and regulations, student support etc;

Experiencing: Subject lectures, study skills, small-group activities, physical activity, creative and performing arts, literary activities, universal human values, etc.

Objectives of an induction program typically include:

1. ***Familiarization with Campus*:** Introduce students to campus facilities, including academic buildings, libraries, and recreational areas.
2. ***Understanding Academic Expectations*:** Explain academic standards, course registration processes, and grading systems.
3. ***Building Connections*:** Facilitate networking opportunities with peers, faculty, and support staff to build a supportive academic community.
4. ***Providing Support Information*:** Inform students about academic advising, mental health resources, financial aid, and other support services.
5. ***Encouraging Involvement*:** Highlight opportunities for involvement in clubs, organizations, and extracurricular activities to enhance their college experience.
6. ***Setting Goals and Expectations*:** Help students set personal and academic goals and understand the expectations for success in their college journey.

Evidence of the Success:

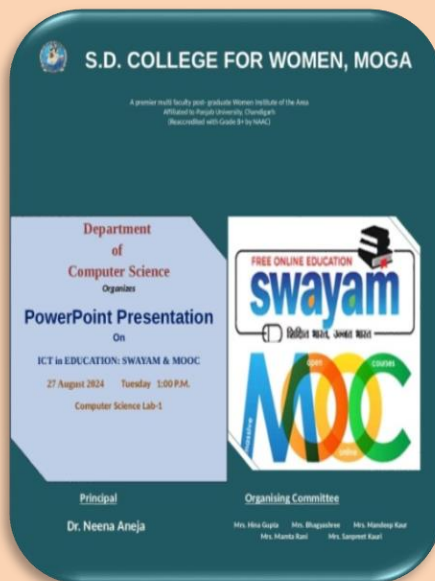

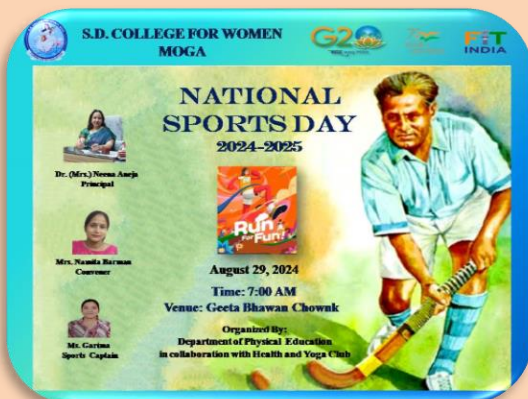

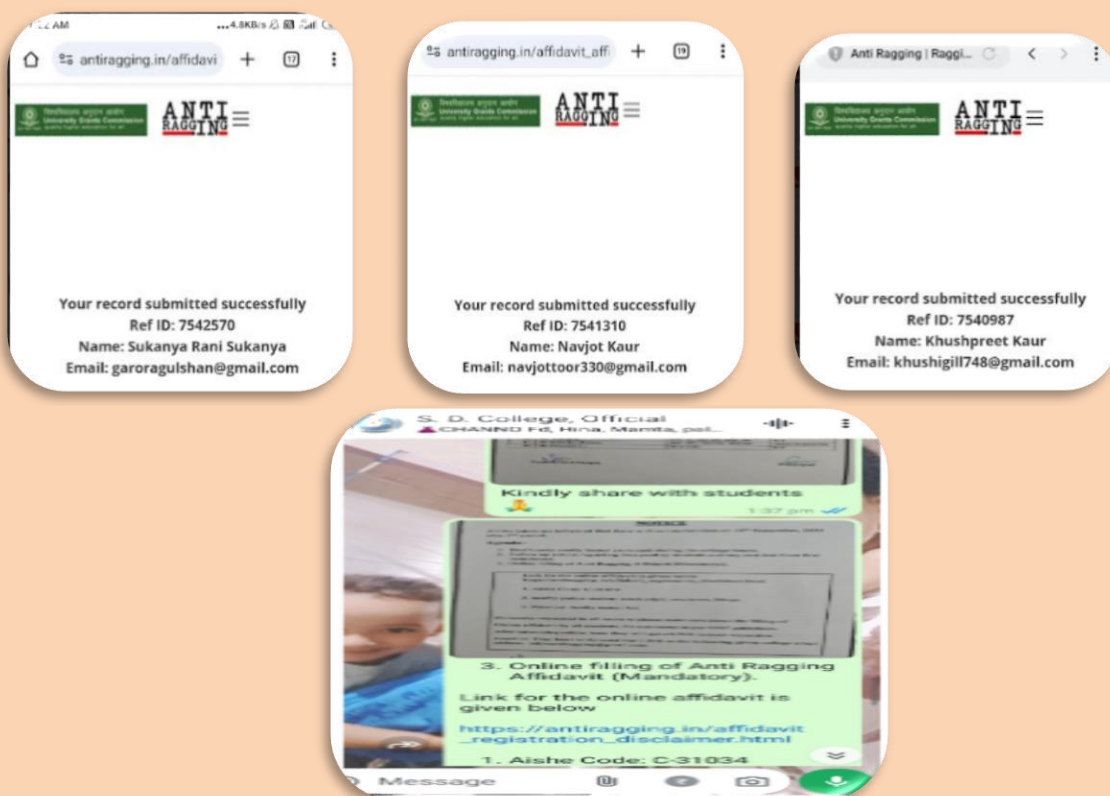
Anti- Ragging Compliance: Mandatory student's affidavit form

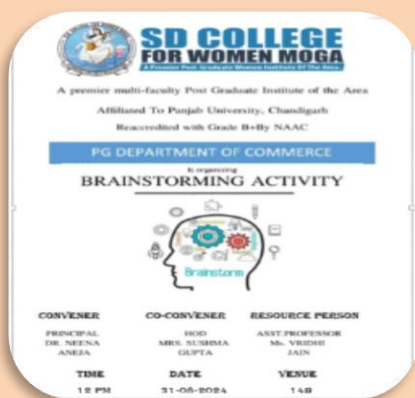
