## What is Sexual Harassment?

**For this purpose, sexual harassment includes unwelcome sexually determined behavior (whether directly or by implication) such as:**

- Verbal or Physical threats.
- Insulting, Abusive, Embarrassing or Patronizing behavior or Comments.
- Offensive gestures, Language, Rumors, Gossip or Jokes.
- Humiliating, Intimidating, Demeaning and/or Persistent criticism, Open hostility.
- Suggestive comments or Body language.
- Isolation or Exclusion from normal work or study place.
- Publishing, Circulating or Displaying pornographic, Racist, Sexually suggestive or Otherwise offensive pictures or other materials.
- Unwanted physical contact, Ranging from an invasion of space to a serious assault (The above list is not intended to be exhaustive)

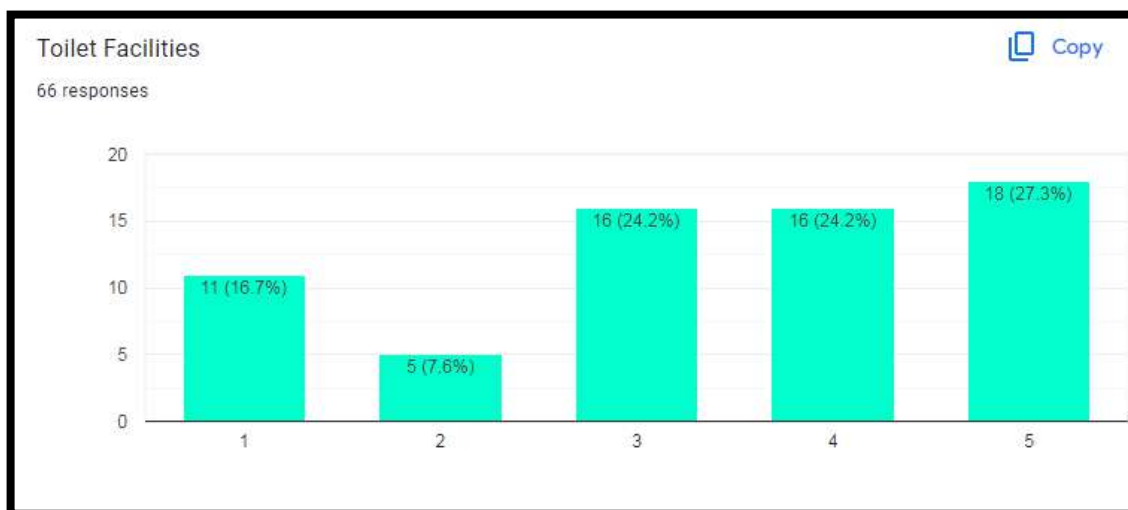

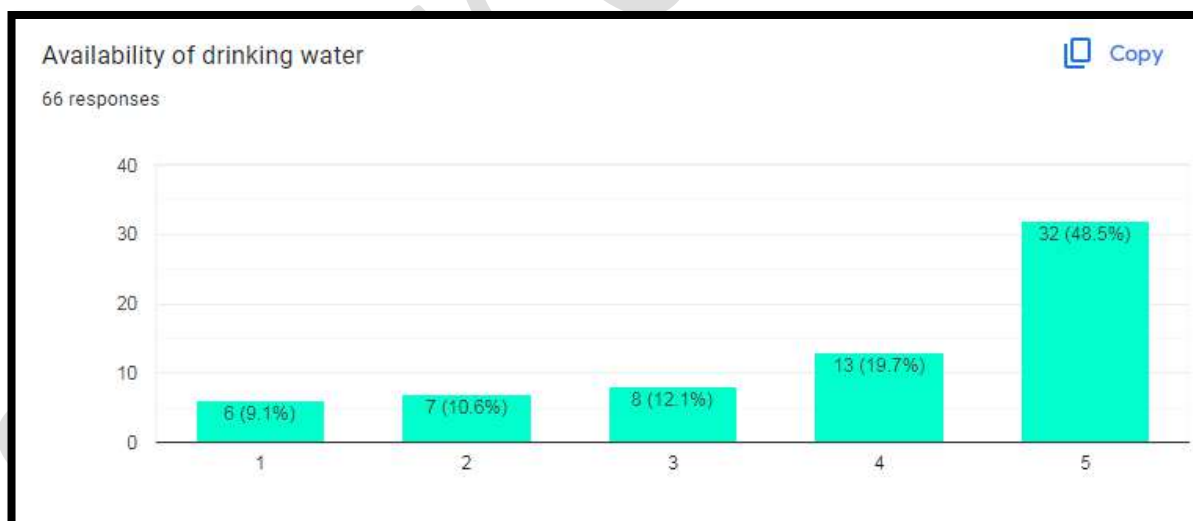

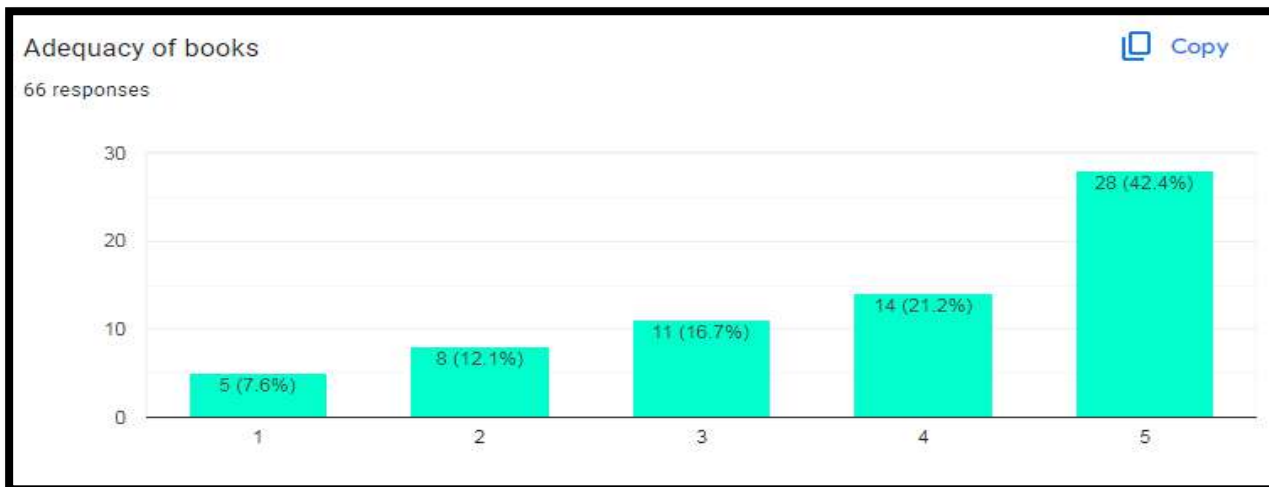

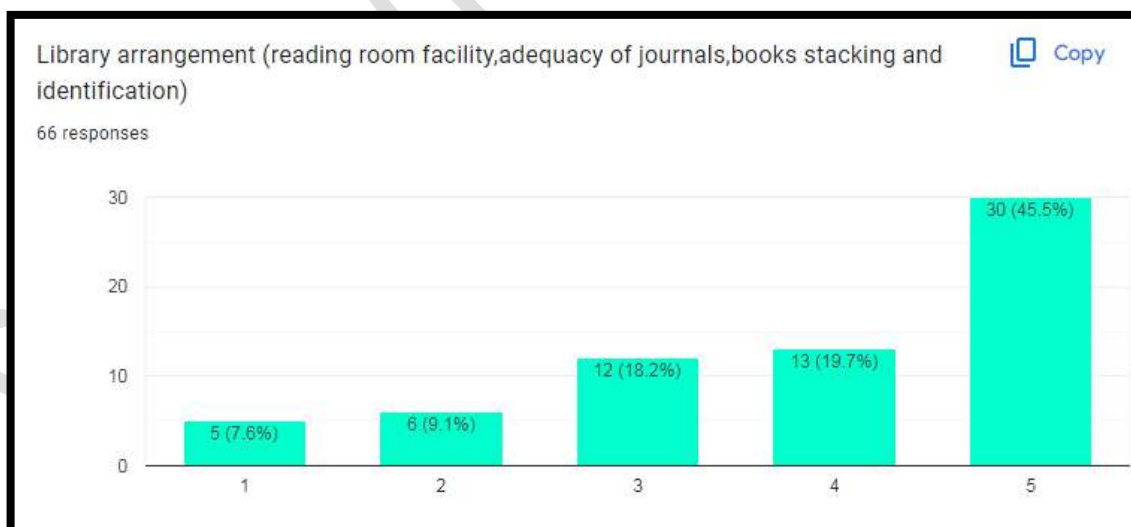

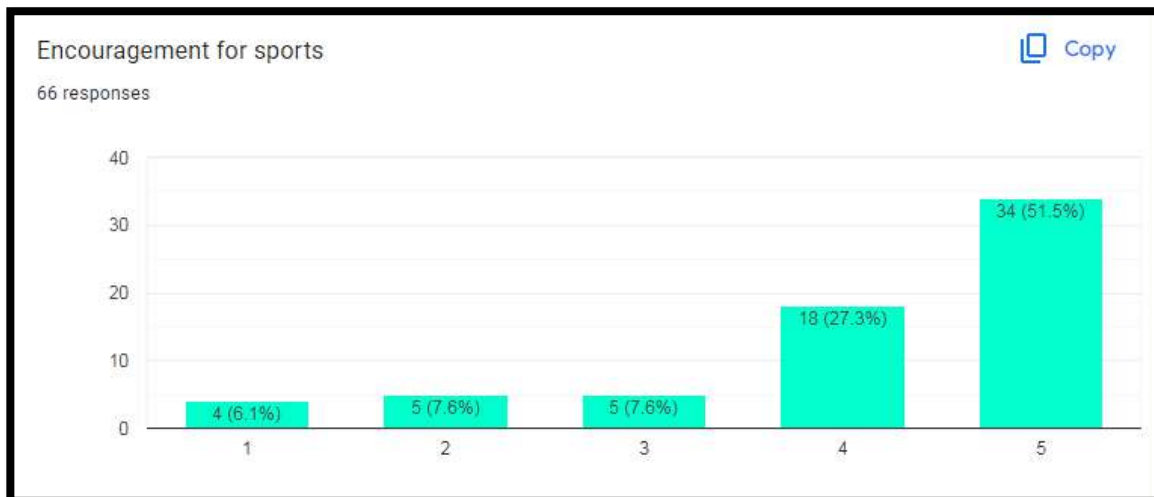

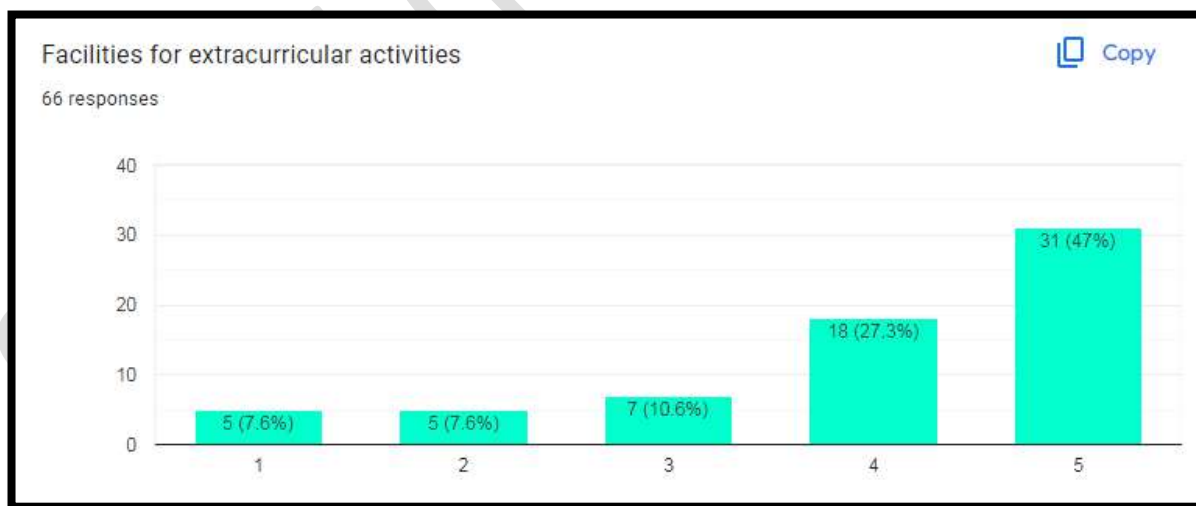

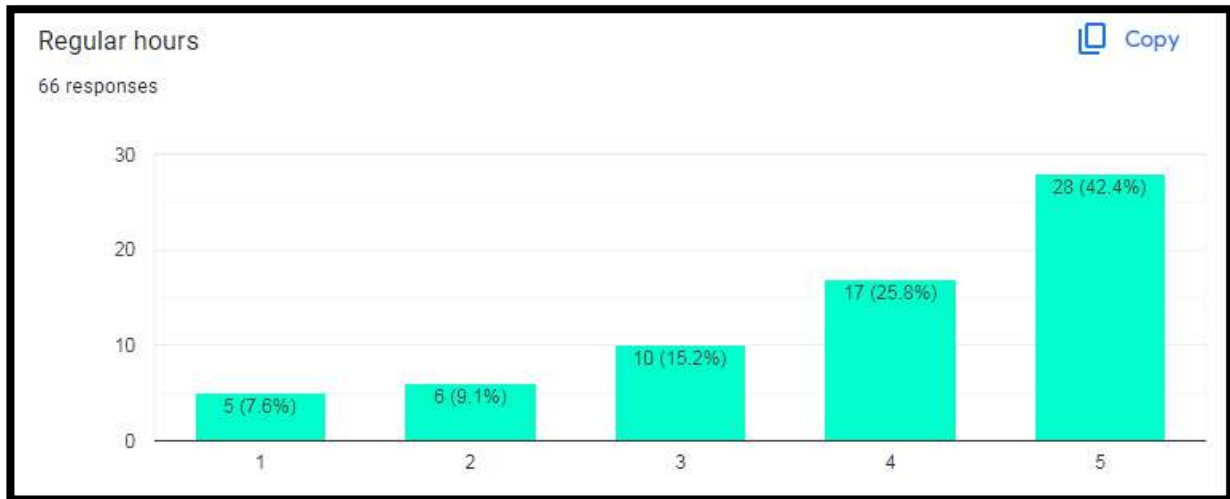

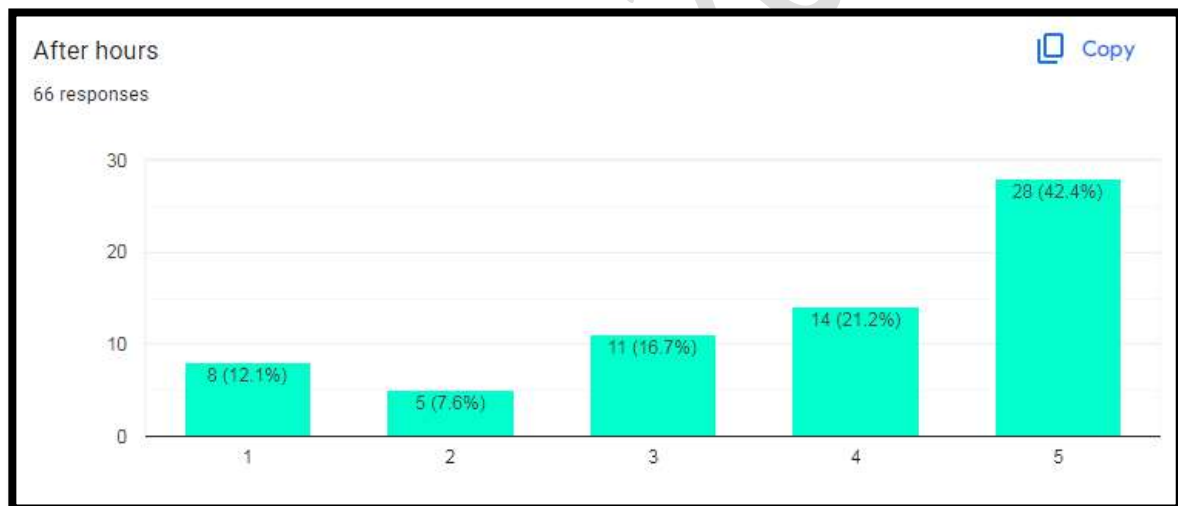

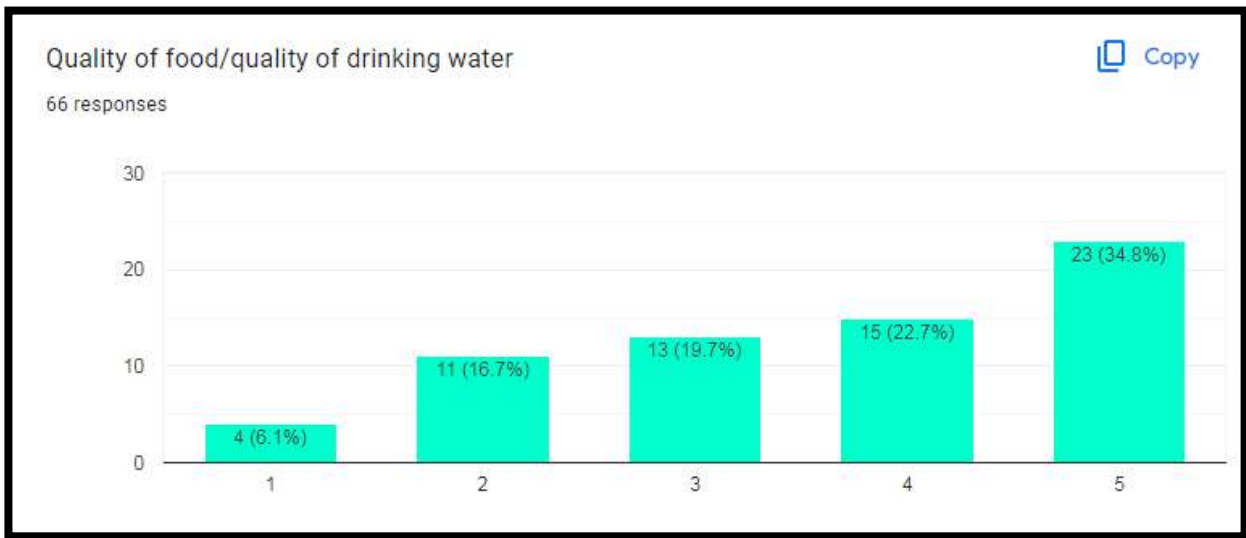

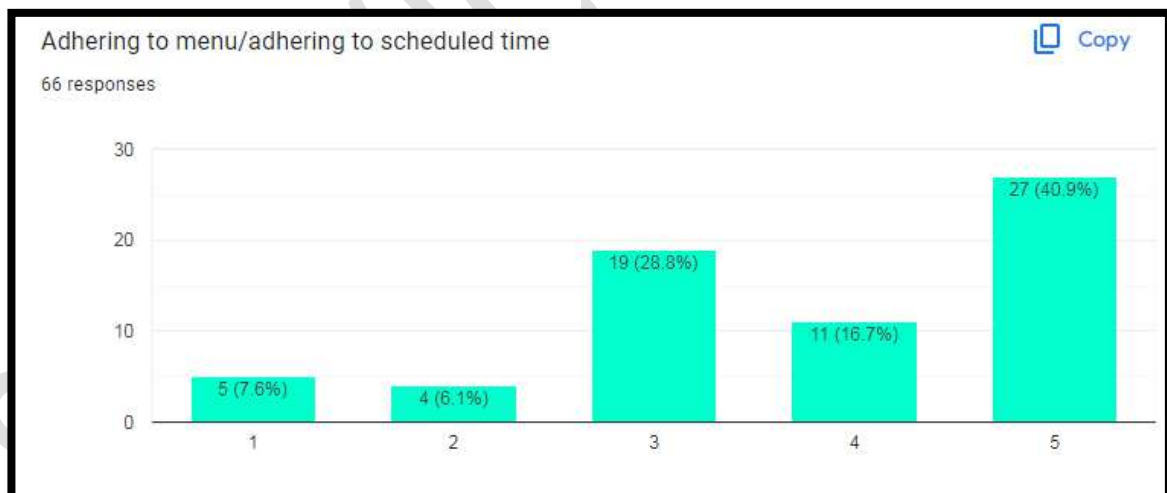

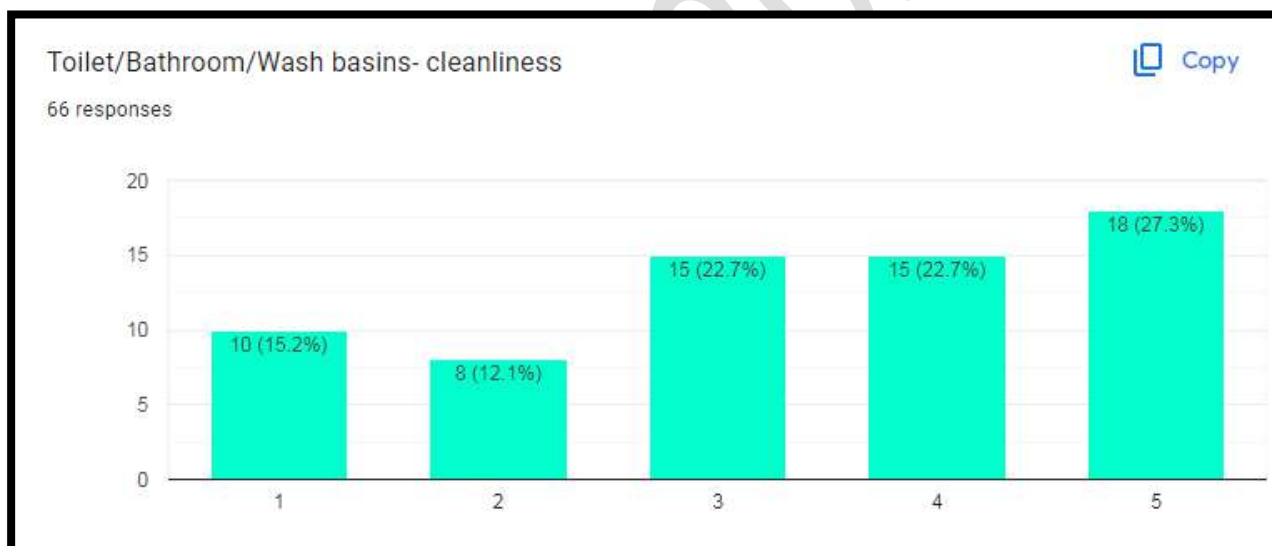

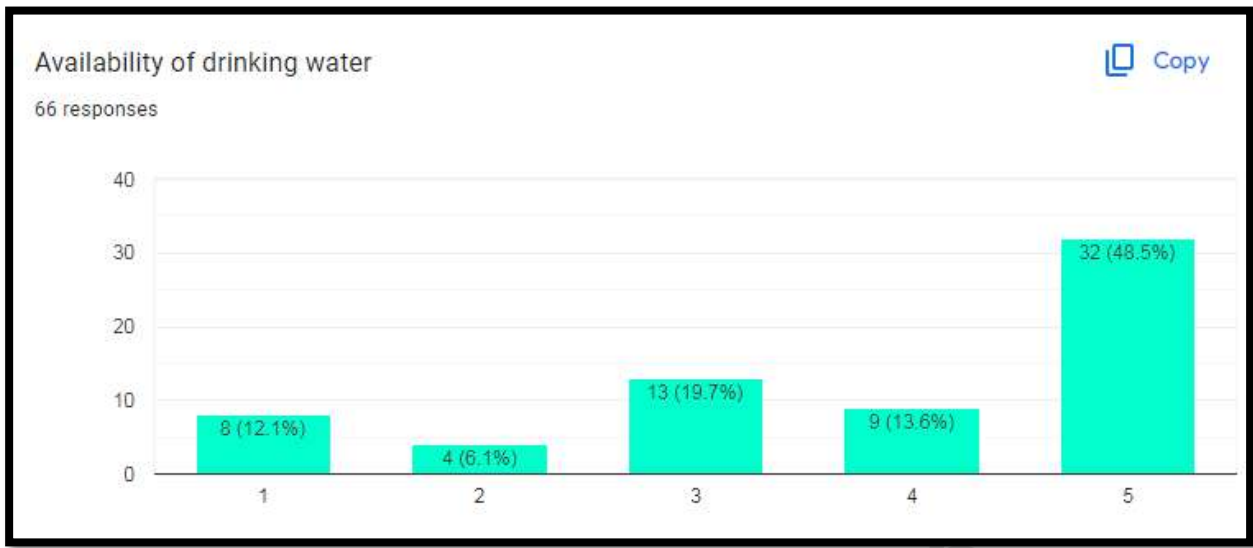

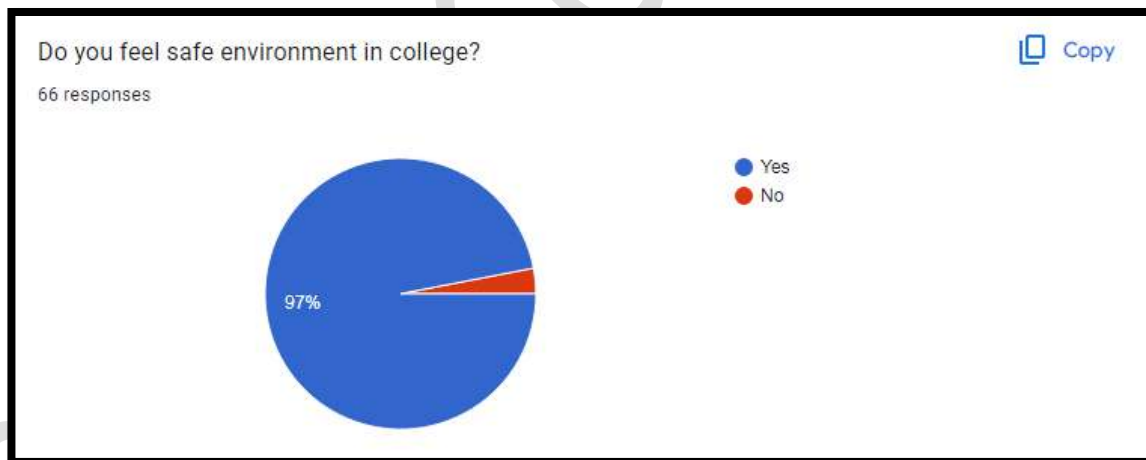

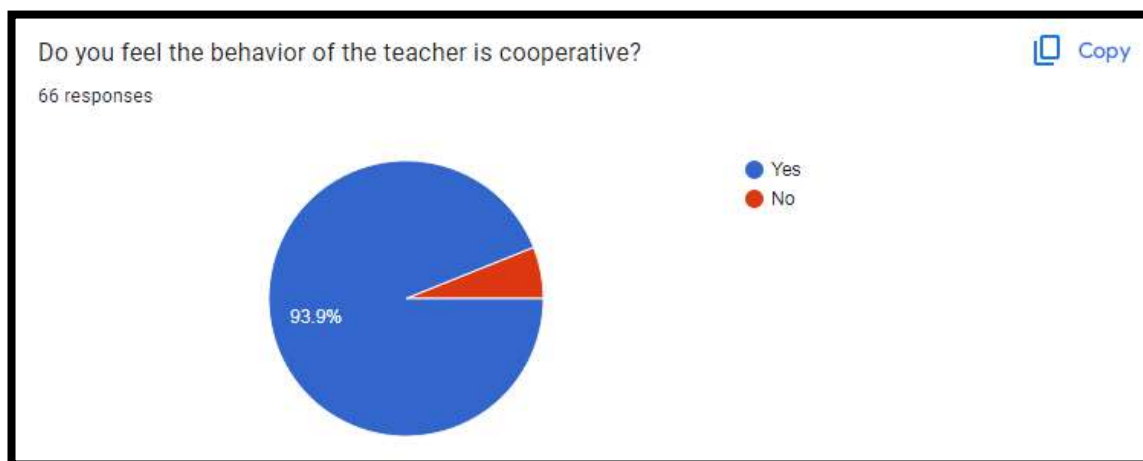
### 17. Do you feel safe environment in college?

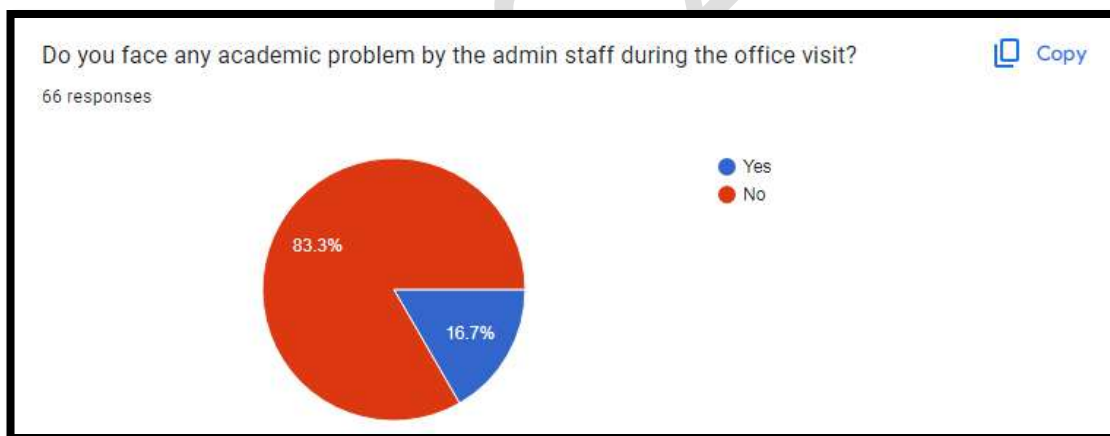

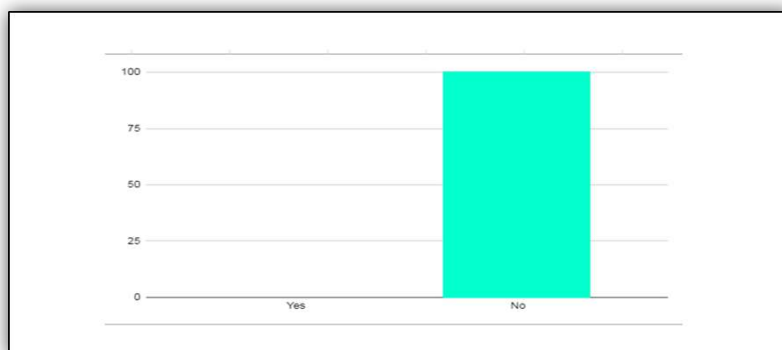


From the above pie chart you see that 83.3% of the students don't face any problem while visiting the admin staff and 16.7 expressed the negative response towards the corporation by the admin staff.

### 20. Do you have any experience of Ragging in college by senior students during first year in college?

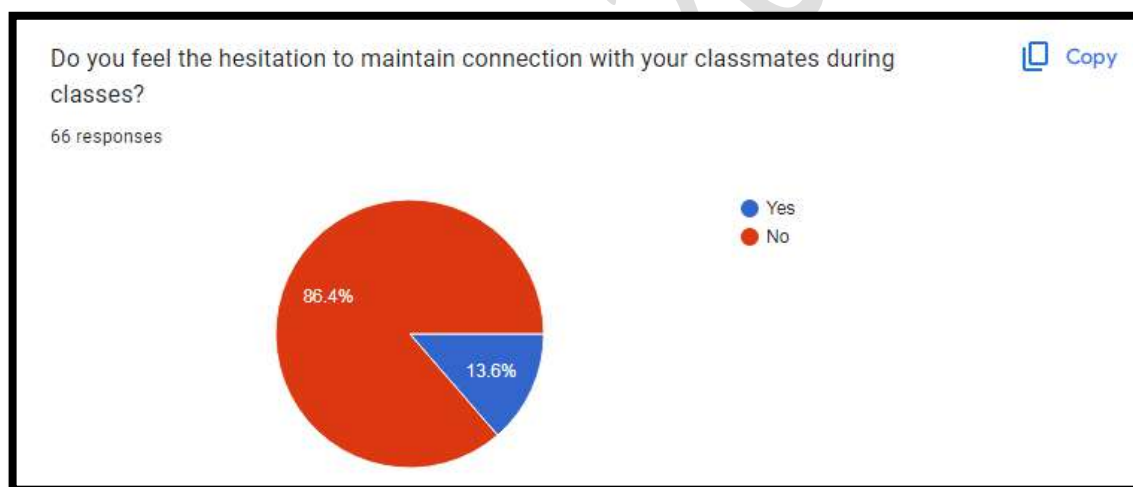

### 21. Do you feel the hesitation to maintain connection with your classmates during classes?

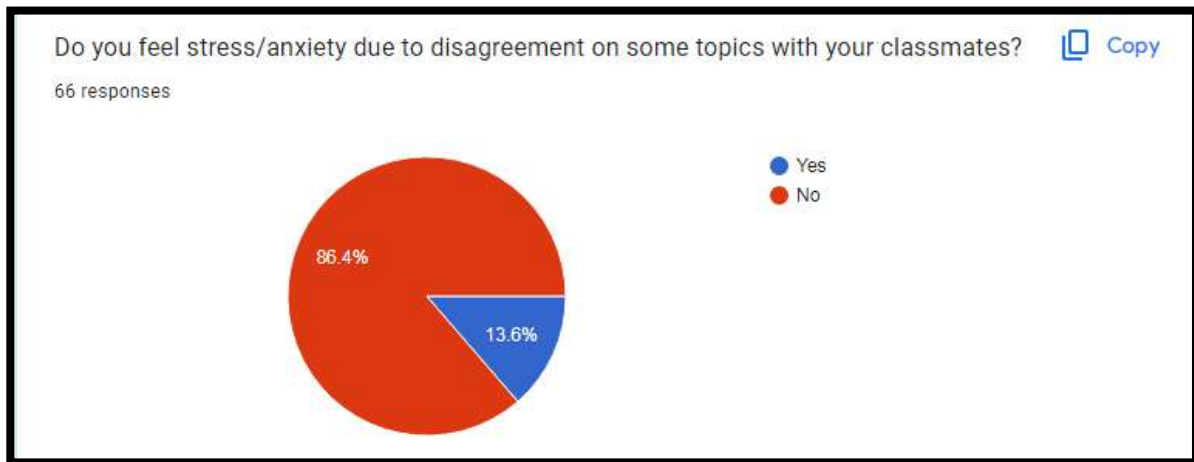

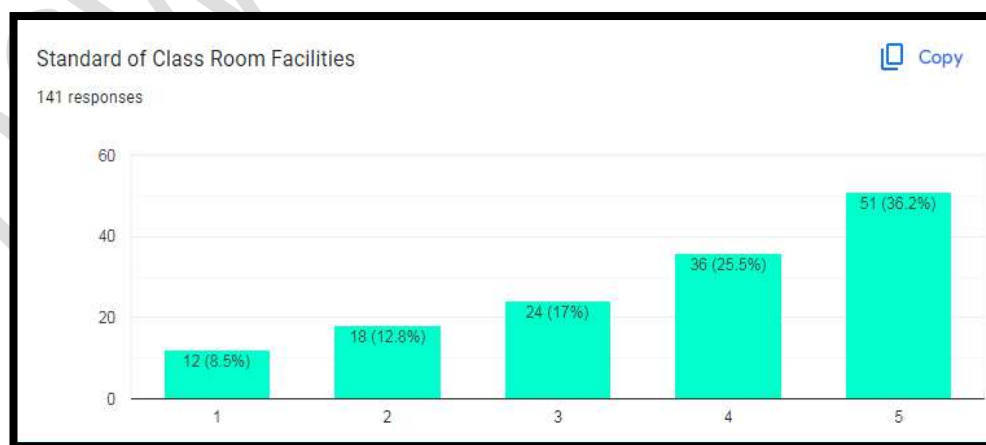
## Result and finding of the survey

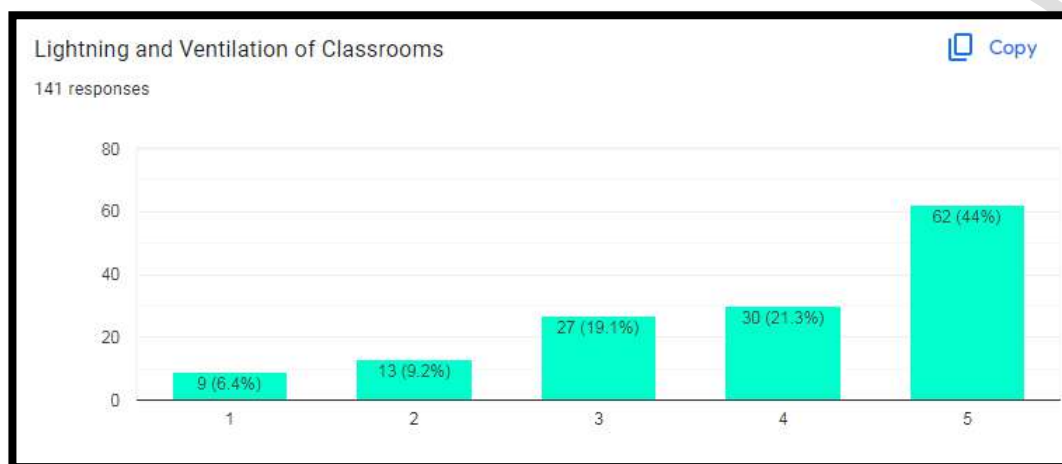

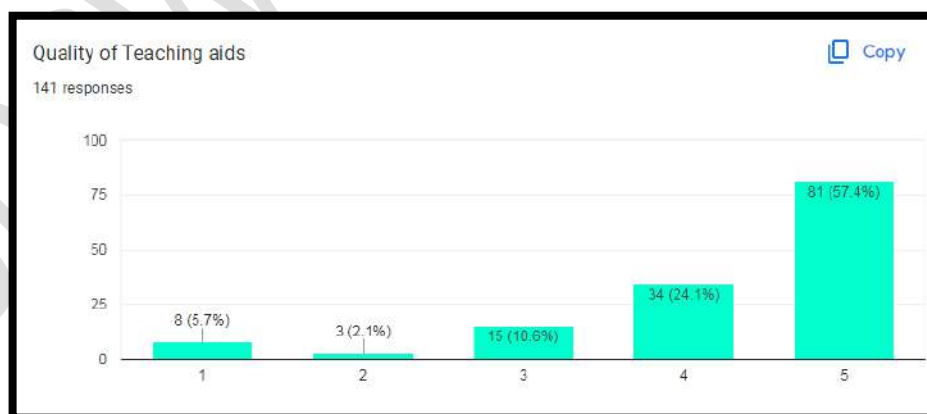
From this Bar Diagram you see that a large majority of the students (78.7%) are satisfied and (12.8%) are having average response, but (8.5%) expressed poor response for the same.

From this Bar Diagram you see that a large majority of the students (84.4%) are satisfied and (9.2%) are having average response, but (6.4%) expressed poor response for the same

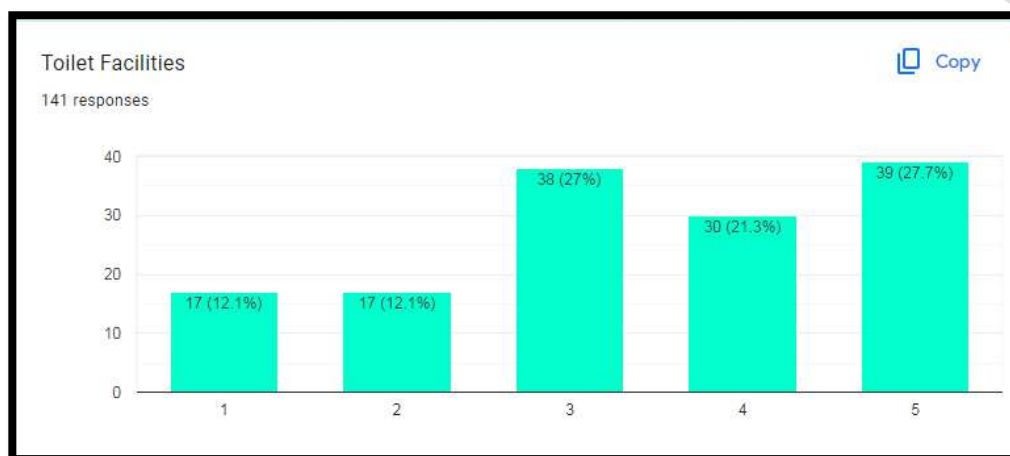

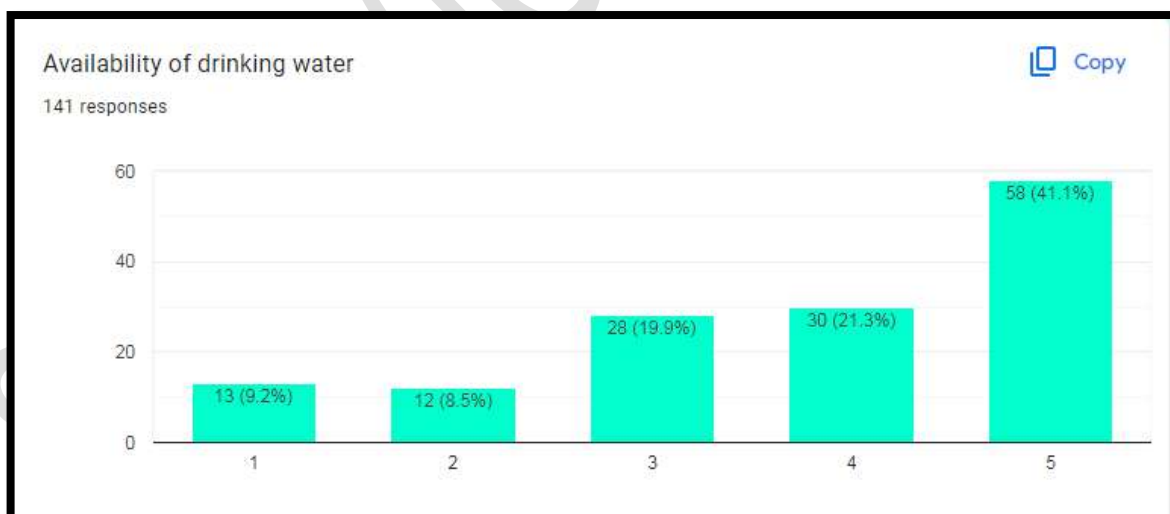

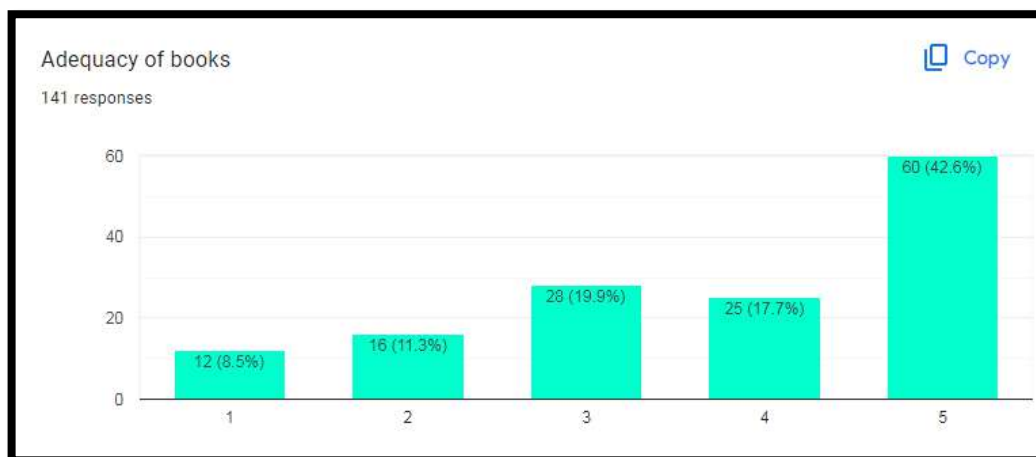

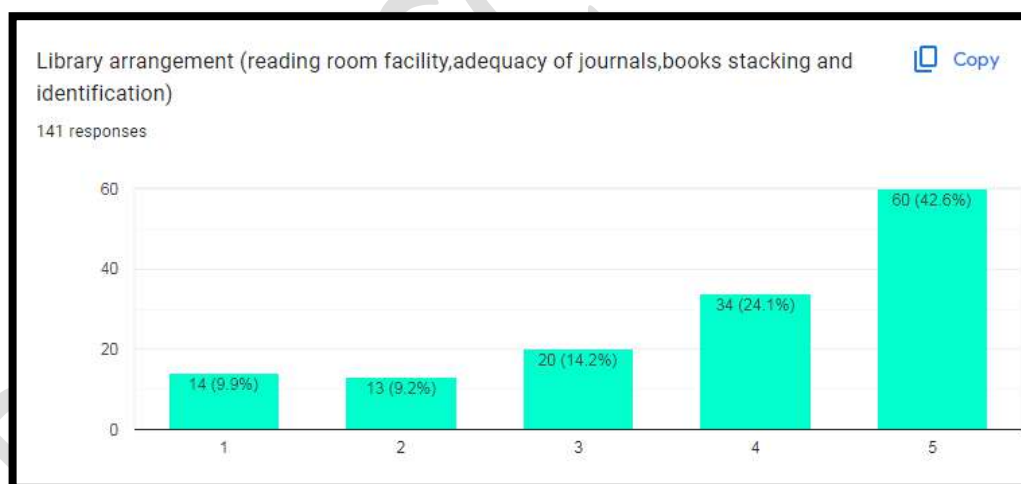

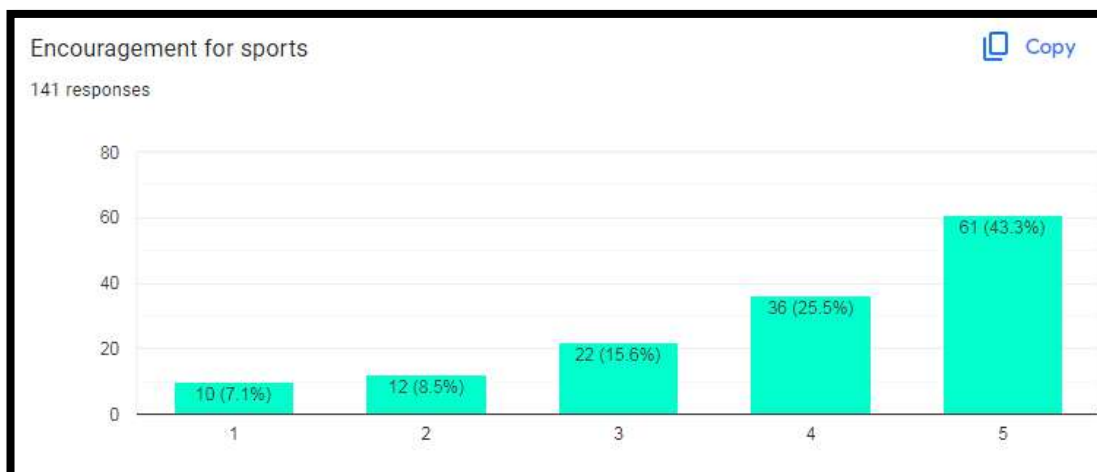

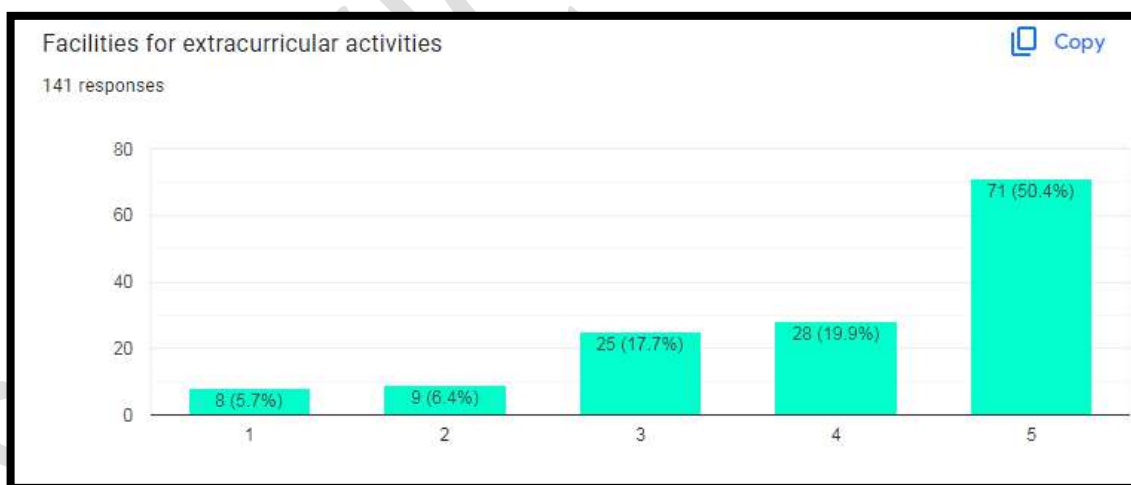

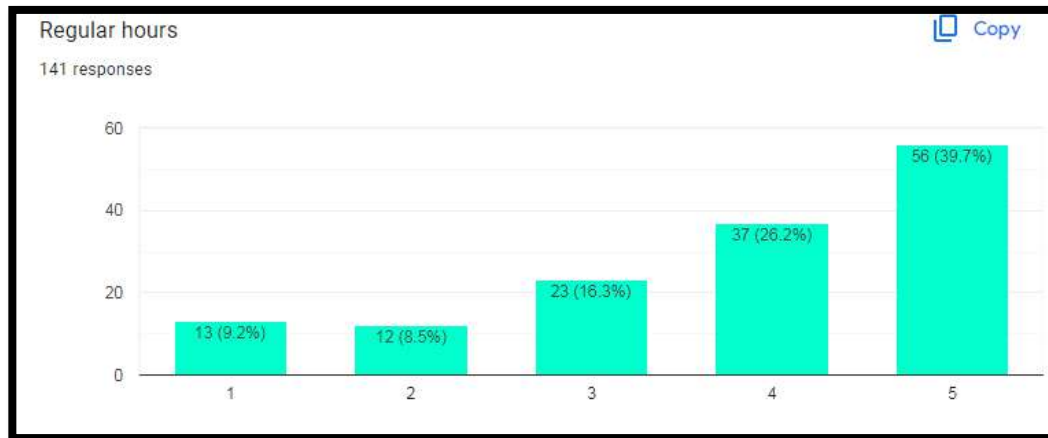

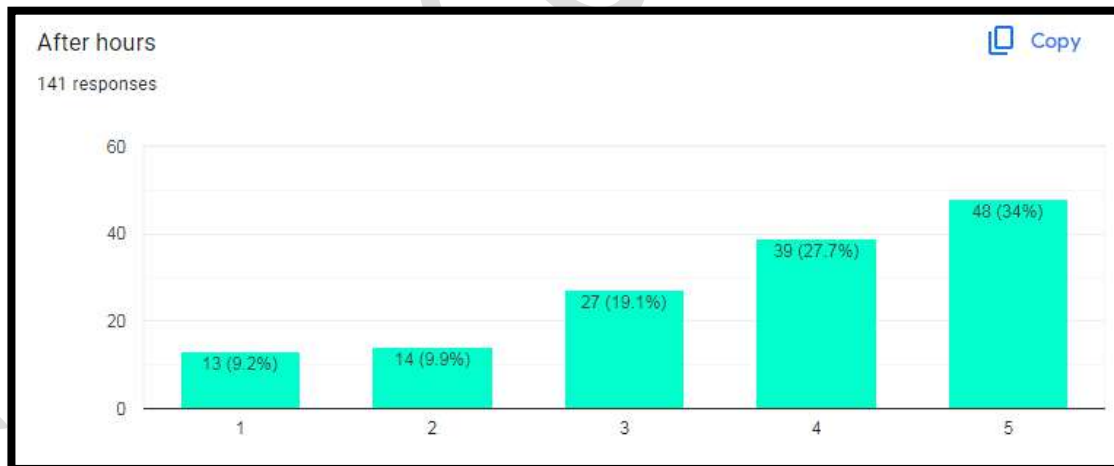

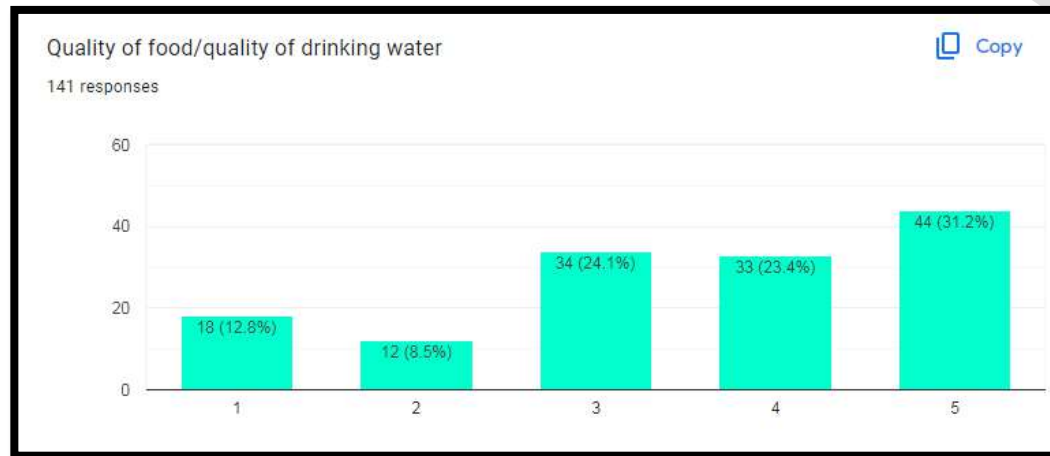

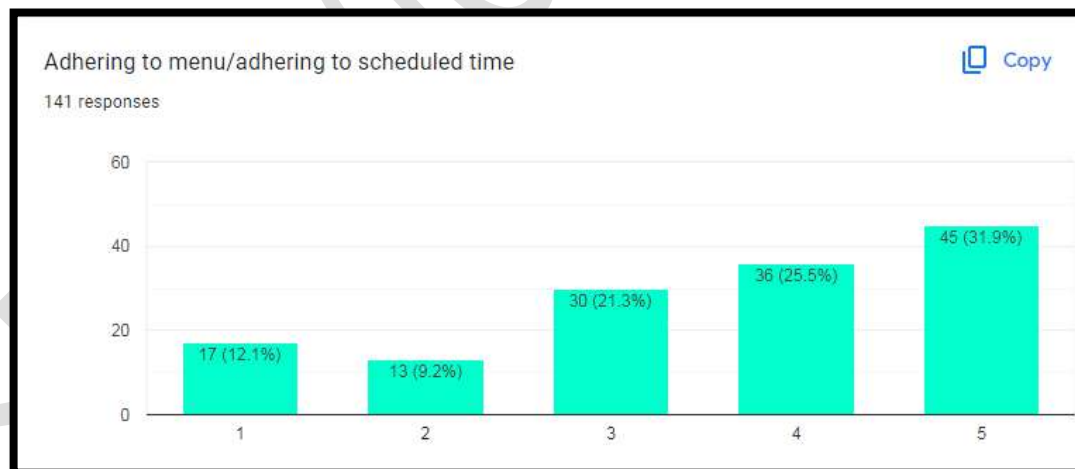

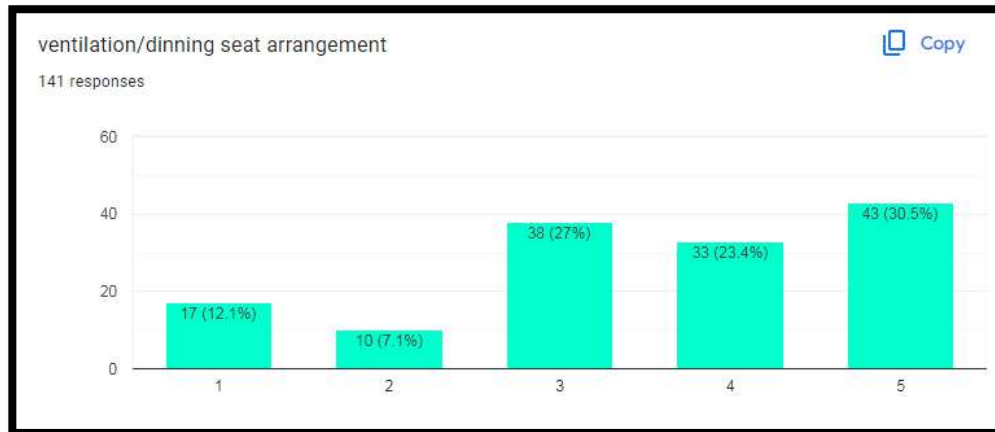

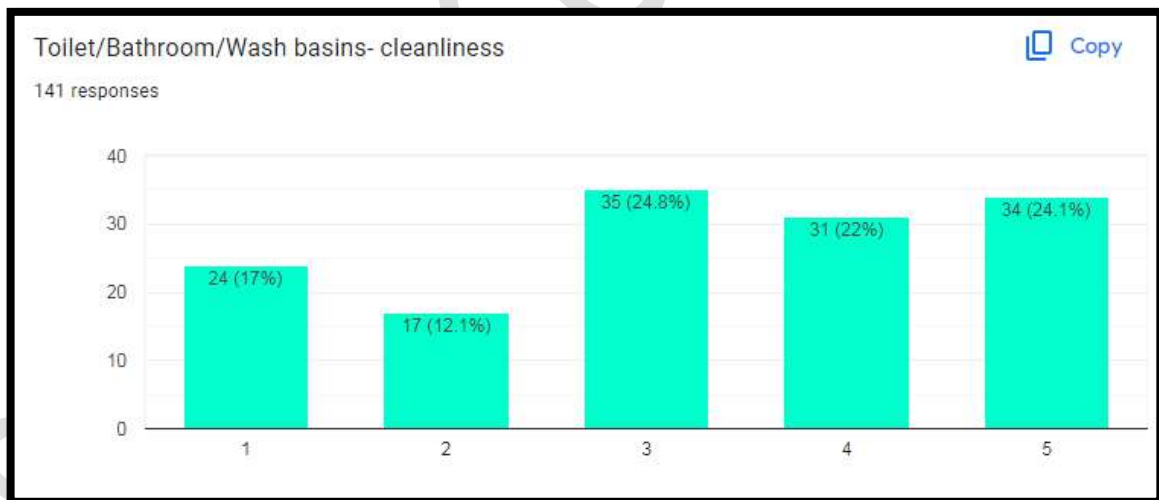

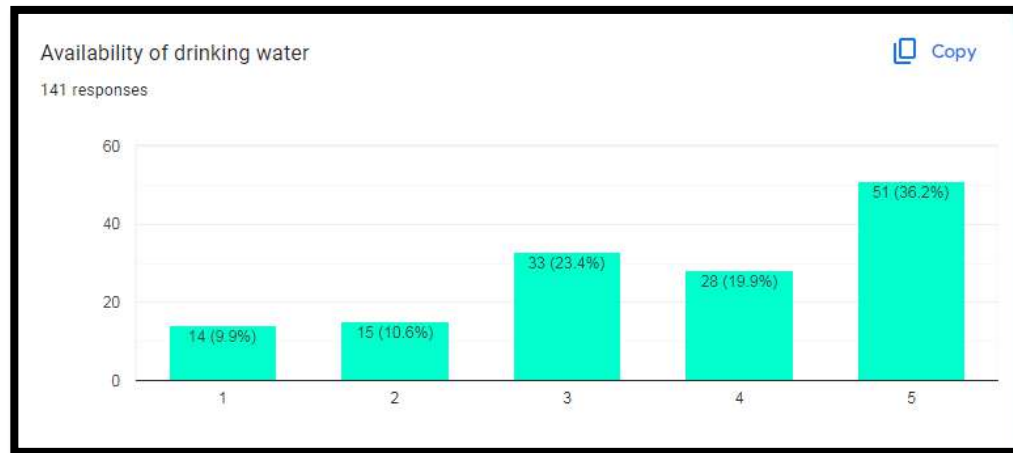

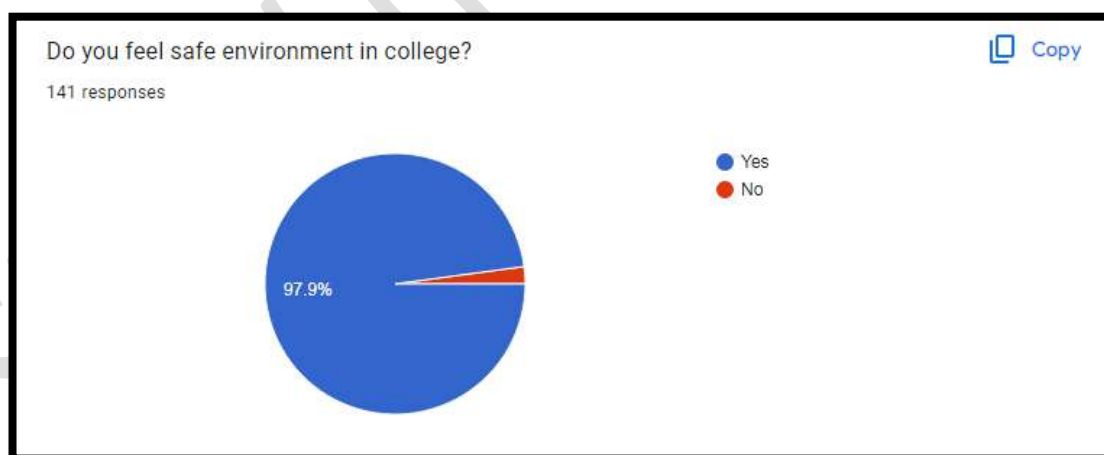

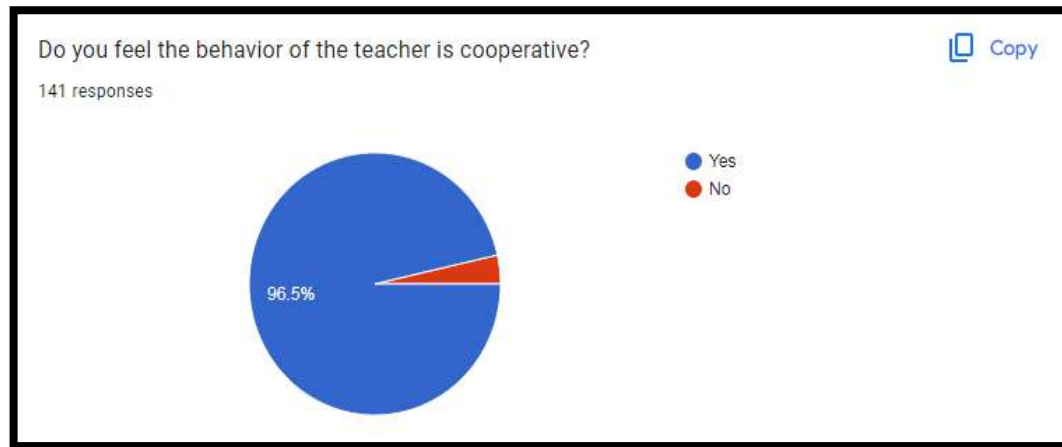


From the above pie chart you see that 97.9% of the students feel safe in the college environment and 2.1% of the students expressed the negative response towards the environment.



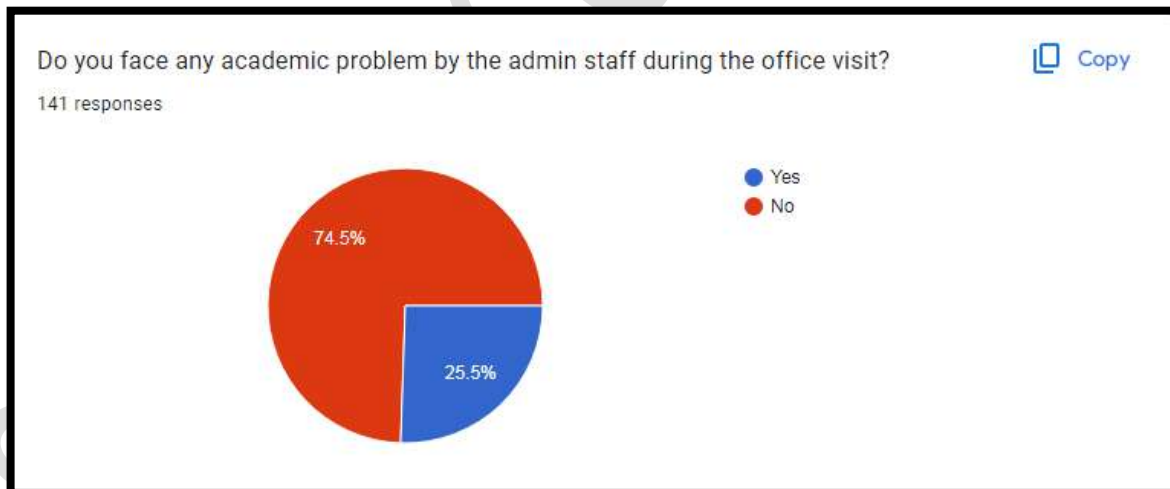

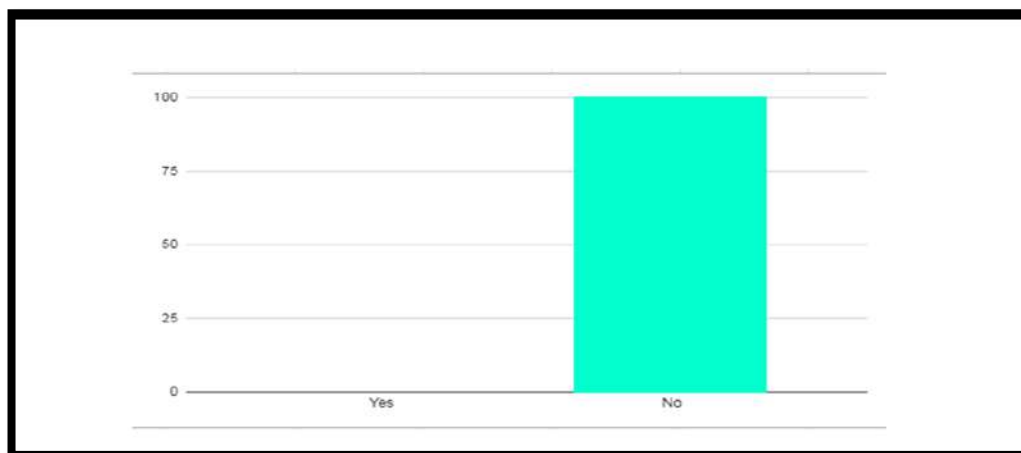
### 19. Do you face any academic problem by the admin staff during the office visit?

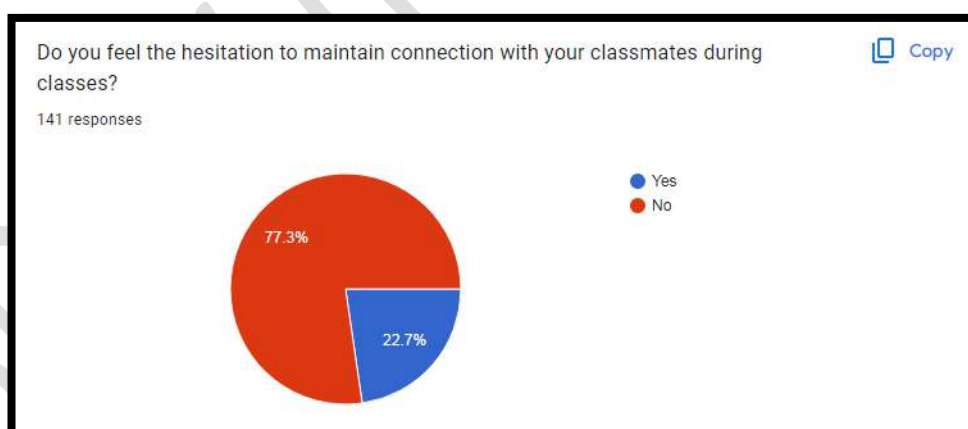

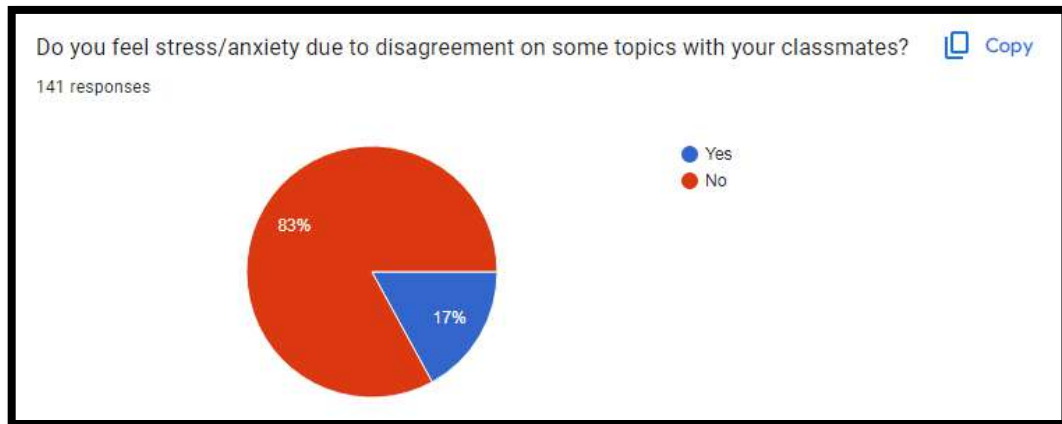
